Policy Title: MULTICULTURAL/GENDER FAIR EDUCATION

The education program shall foster knowledge of and respect and appreciation for the historical and contemporary contributions of diverse cultural groups, as well as men and women, to society. The contributions and perspectives of Asian Americans, African Americans, Hispanic Americans, American Indians, European Americans, and persons with disabilities shall be included in the program. The educational program will also reflect the wide variety of roles open to both men and women and provide equal opportunity to both sexes.
