Policy Title: SCHOOL DISTRICT WEB PAGE

The Internet provides a valuable learning tool for students and staff and offers another communications vehicle for informing the public about school programs and activities. The board authorizes the establishment of a school district web page and individual attendance center web pages. Only those web pages approved by the superintendent and maintained in accordance with board policy and administrative procedures will be recognized as official representations of the school district.

The superintendent is responsible for assigning an individual responsible for maintaining the web pages. The superintendent, or his/her designee, will develop administrative regulations regarding the web site.
