BJ Tegeler called the meeting to order at 6:03 pm.

Minutes from the June 15 meeting were reviewed. Motion to approve was made by Darlene Lamp, second by Jamie Burken. All ayes.

Treasurer’s report was shared. Motion to approve treasurers report was made by Darlene Lamp, second by David Johnson. All ayes.

Old Business:

Special Vote from July 21 – With the softball team making it to the state tournament, a special e-vote was made on July 21 to approve our support when teams/individuals go to state. The boosters will reimburse the sports fund at the school \$50 per student for state tournament participation. For the softball team, 18 students went so a check for \$900 will be paid to the softball fund at Northeast.

2020/2021 Sponsorship – So far we are at the highest number of sponsors ever and they are still steadily coming in. Erin is trying to market the “Booster Backer” supporter. This is a \$50 donation from Rebel families. She encouraged all to share this opportunity with family and friends, especially those with students in sports.

Rebel Run/Walk – To date we have 26 participants registered. It was decided to keep registration open until Noon on Friday, August 7. Troy will send out a JMC email to the entire district. Jamie was going to contact the Cross Country coach to push for their members to participate. Online participation awards will begin the week of August 17. Erin will purchase three \$25 value gift cards for prizes.

Video Scoreboard Panels – Total of three sponsors purchased at the panel level. First Central State Bank will get their own panel at the top. Troy suggested to have the other two sponsors share the other top panel and then use the bottom for wording from the boosters with white space on either side to add sponsor information if we sell more. Jami Ohrt recommended Octographics in Clinton for the

vinyl install. She also said her brother-in-law would be able to assist with a boom truck if needed. The first home event is August 28<sup>th</sup> so we will push to get the logos installed by then.

**New Business:**

Fall Sports/Concessions update – Troy gave an update on what Fall sports will look like. He recommended we continue to plan as if concession stands will be allowed. He has a statewide activities director meeting tomorrow that he will learn more details. Volleyball will be played on only one net per gym. Admission fees will be able to be paid with debit/credit cards if entrants do not want to use cash.

Next meeting will be held WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 at the NE High School – Room location TBD. Meetings will be held on the first Monday of the month from October on.
