Dear Northeast Community,

Thank you for supporting our student activities as we navigate through our current reality with the COVID-19 pandemic. At this time, there have been some slight changes with Governor Reynolds' most recent proclamation that will have an effect on Northeast student activities.

Middle School Student Activities

- All middle school extracurricular activities may resume on Thursday, December 10th.
- This currently will include middle school wrestling and girls basketball.
 - 7th grade girls basketball will resume on Friday, December 11th
 - 8th grade girls basketball and wrestling will resume on Monday, December 14th.
- Middle school strength and conditioning will resume AFTER winter break.
- Middle school games/meets are currently being scheduled based on other area schools who are resuming middle school activities.

High School Student Activities

- High school student activities will proceed as scheduled with, **only two spectators per participant per event.**
- New changes to the governor's proclamation include:
 - Students who are scheduled to perform at an event will be allowed to have two spectators attend. This includes the pep band, cheerleaders, and chamber choir. Spectator tickets for each scheduled event will be sent home with students prior to the event.

Community Use of District Facilities

- At this time district facilities will remain **closed** to community use. District administration will re-evaluate the possibility of reopening facilities after winter break.

We would also like to remind our community to be very diligent as we continue into the holiday season. We strongly encourage the community to follow CDC and IDPH guidance for social distancing, masking, and gathering that consist of members of your household. By adhering to these guidelines, we reduce the potential risk for possible exposure which could lead to quarantine or isolation.
